Details:

- In order to be considered for a donation, the following application must be filled out completely and returned to the Blue Jackets no later than **February 26, 2010**
- Any organization applying for "Vermettes Vault" tickets must be a 501 (c) (3) charitable organization serving Central Ohio and/or the Ohio area
- Organizations must use tickets to bring constituents to games - tickets cannot be used for fundraising purposes, staff incentives, etc...
- Organizations must be able to guarantee that seats will be filled
- Organizations serving youth and adolescents will be given preference
- Suite includes up to 12 event tickets, light snacks, non-alcoholic beverages & 2 Nationwide Arena parking garage passes - you have the opportunity to purchase additional food from the concession stands and bring the food purchased into the suite
- Of the up to 12 tickets, a minimum of 6 children/teenagers are required to attend this event

The Vermettes are not able to consider the following requests for approval:

- Those made by individuals
- Those to be used for event sponsorship (e.g. raffles, door prizes, auctions)
- Political events and campaigns
- Labor groups
- Endowments and capital campaigns
- Organizations that discriminate on the basis of race, sex, sexual orientation, age or religion.

All applications will be reviewed at the end of each month and notifications will be mailed immediately following.
