**Scholarship Criteria:**

Applicant must be a high school senior.

Applicant must be a team member of one of the following high school teams: Archbishop Moeller, Athens, Bishop Watterson, Dublin Coffman, Dublin Jerome, Dublin Scioto, Gahanna Lincoln, Hilliard/Southwest, Newark, Northeast, Olentangy, Olentangy Liberty, Olentangy Orange, PRPC, St. Charles, St. Francis DeSales, Thomas Worthington, Upper Arlington, Westerville or Worthington Kilbourne.

Applicant must plan to attend accredited two or four year US college/university as a full-time student beginning the summer or fall immediately following high school graduation.

Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or better (based on a 4.0 scale) or its equivalent and student shall be evaluated based upon all academic work completed through the first term in which the final season of eligibility concludes.

Scholarships range in value from \$2,500 - \$5,000.

Applicant must have performed with distinction in terms of leadership, realizing potential, character and positive attitude as a member of the hockey team. Applicant conducted himself/herself, both on and off the ice, in a manner that has brought credit to the student and their institution.

In addition to the above, consideration shall be given to participation in school activities, other than academic and athletic, in which the student has had the opportunity to demonstrate qualities of leadership and serve as an example to fellow students.
